01 Welcome

The Gaia-X Hubs, are an important part of the Gaia-X project. As national contact points for our international community, they help shape and develop the project and its public image. To support both, an individual and to Gaia-X standrads aligned online presence of each of the national Hubs the Gaia-X Association provides this online styleguide. Since many hubs use the websites of ministries or member companies for their online presence, the technical basis (content management system) and structure are usually fixed. However, This style guide is intended to help the hub teams to design their websites in the corporate design of Gaia-X, but still individually. It contains useful information on the use of fonts, colours, photos and the logo.

O1 Agreement on the trademark use






Website layout overview



04 Header logo placement

The **Gaia-X Hub logo** should always be placed on the upper left hand side of the website and to the left of the main menu. Always place the logo on a white background to ensure best visibility. Keep in mind the minimum distances to surrounding elements when positioning the logo (as described on the right).



Placement of the logo on the left hand side of the menu




05 Background colours

Content can be structured by using different coloured backgrounds. The website should appear light. Darker coloures are used sparingly to highlight specific content, such as the website title.

Gradient background: This background can be used for the title headline in the header area or as a background for icons.

White and grey backgrounds: These backgrounds can be used for content with text and images.

Dark blue background: Dark blue is only used for the website footer.



07 Imagery pictures

To give photos of different types a uniform look, a subtle image filter is used. A gradient in a defined shade of blue (RGB 35-80-255) leads (at an angle of 35°) from the upper left corner of the image from 50% opacity to 15% in the centre and the right part of the image.

In this way, images can be edited quickly and easily, e.g. for news articles on the website, and still have a slight Gaia-X branding.


Photos can be placed on the white and grey background.



08 Graphics icons

Icons coloured in Gaia-X purple and Gaia-X blue





You are allowed to use any icon as long as copyrights are cleared. Icons can be placed on white or grey backgrounds and on the gradient background. They should be drawn with outlines in medium thickness and should not be drawn with fill colours.

For white or grey backgrounds the icons should be coloured in monochrome Gaia-X purple or in a combination of Gaia-X purple and Gaia-X blue.


If icons are placed on the gradient background they can be used in two colours. They can either be coloured in monochrome Gaia-X turquoise or in a combination of Gaia-X turquoise and white. They can also be coloured in monochrome Gaia-X purple or a combination of Gaia-X purple and white.


Icons should not be coloured in monochrome


In case existing icons are used they need to be coloured in monochrome Gaia-X purple on white or grey backgrounds, or in monochrome Gaia-X purple or turquoise on the gradient background. Please only use icons with outlines. Never use fully coloured icons.

09 Buttons and links

There are two types of buttons. A button with the fill colour Gaia-X purple and white text. It is used for "Calls to action", which need to be highlighted on the page.

A button with an outline and the text in Gaia-X blue is used for loading additional content on a page or is used to navigate to different contents. Both types of buttons use rounded corners (2 px).

Text links use the same colour as the body text. In the case of text links on white or grey backgrounds the text colour is grey (HEX #A2A2A2). In the case of text links on the dark blue or the gradient backgrounds the text colour is white. Text links can be set in Titilium Regular or Medium and should always be set with an underline.
