UP AND RUNNING

Gaia-X is very much alive and keeps working toward its objective to bridge the gap between technology regulation and regulation technology, as per the new phrase coined by its CEO, Francesco Bonfiglio, to define the industry-led initiative, which at first suffered from some misunderstanding of what its purpose was. “Anyone could think whatever they wanted of Gaia-X or, better, anyone could think whatever they expected of Gaia-X,” Bonfiglio told Morning Tech, stressing that the definition phase is over. “We are in the delivery year,” he said, with the launch last month of its Clearing House, a one-stop solution for verifying compliance with the Gaia-X rules, and the many data exchange platforms built under the umbrella of the “lighthouse projects.”

AI needs cloud: The association is now on deck to work on solving the actual problem that Europe is facing: the gap between the “increasing amount of regulation” and the “capability of implementing it,” Bonfiglio argued. He hopes that the solutions developed by Gaia-X will help “destroy the access barriers” on the market and foster the take up of cloud in Europe, at a time when artificial intelligence has become the buzzword. “Cloud is still the motorway of data,” fueling the AI boom today, he said.
